GOD DESERVES OUR WORSHIP

Leviticus 1-4

God gave laws to show His people what holy living looks like. God gave His people rules about how to live, how to worship, and what to do when they sinned.

God met with Moses at the tabernacle. God told Moses, “Speak to the Israelites and tell them what to do when they bring an offering to Me.” Different types of offerings were needed at different times.

Priests made the sacrifices that God commanded. God gave them rules about how to offer sacrifices.

When people wanted to praise God, they gave burnt offerings. God deserves our praise.

When people wanted to thank God, they gave grain offerings. God deserves our thanks. When people wanted to celebrate God, they gave fellowship offerings. God deserves to be celebrated.

When people wanted to say they were sorry for sin, they gave a sin offering. God is honored when people turn away from their sin and turn back to Him. The priest gave an offering so the people could be forgiven.

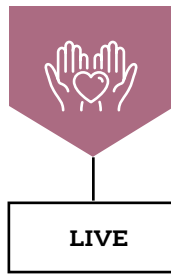
