



## **BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:**

- The people did not trust God to lead them into the promised land, so they had to walk around in the wilderness.
- God told Moses to speak to a rock to give the people water.
- Moses disobeyed God and hit the rock two times instead.
- The people drank the water, but God said Moses would not enter the promised land because he disobeyed.
- God planned to give His people a new leader.

## **CHRIST CONNECTION:**

Moses disobeyed God, so he could not go into the promised land. God sent Jesus, who always obeyed God. When we trust in Jesus, He brings us into God's kingdom forever.

## **KEY PASSAGE PHRASE:**

We praise the one true God. He does wonderful things. Exodus 15:11

### **Family Discussion Starters:**

- · What is one thing you remember from this week's Bible story?
- •What did God tell Moses and Aaron to do to get water for the people and animals?
- · Why do you think Moses and Aaron didn't obey God?
- · Why is it important for us to obey God?

### **Family Activities:**

- Allow each family member to tell a time she has disobeyed and the consequences she received. Remind your children of the consequences of Moses and Aaron disobeying God's instructions.
- •As you use water throughout the day, talk about the various ways your family uses water. Help your preschoolers understand if we didn't have water, we wouldn't be able to do things discussed. Talk about how the Israelites didn't trust God to give them water. Review the Bible story.
