BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Paul, a follower of Jesus, wrote a letter to Timothy, a younger leader in the church.
- Paul told Timothy that many people will dishonor God and choose sin.
- Timothy needed to know what was true, so Paul reminded him that Scripture is completely trustworthy.
- The Bible is inspired by God, which means it is God's Word.

CHRIST CONNECTION:

Paul wrote to teach Timothy how to live for God. The Bible tells us about God's plan for people to have forgiveness through His Son, Jesus. Jesus obeyed God's Word perfectly. We can follow Jesus' example to read, believe, and obey the Bible as we live for God's glory.

KEY PASSAGE: Psalm 119:105
