THE BIBLE HELPS US LIVE FOR GOD 2 Timothy 3

Paul wrote a letter to his friend Timothy. Paul was a follower of Jesus. He was also a missionary. Timothy had traveled with Paul and now was a leader at a church.

Two letters from Paul to Timothy are part of the Bible. In the second letter, Paul wrote: "Hard times are coming. Some people will not live for God. They will love themselves and money most of all. Instead of loving God, they will do whatever feels good to them.

"You know me well, and you even suffered like I did. Everyone who wants to live for Jesus will face hard times, too. From the time you were a child, you learned from Scripture. The Scriptures give you the wisdom you need to be saved."

Paul said, "All Scripture is inspired by God. It is useful for teaching, for rebuking, for correcting, and for training in righteousness. With the Bible, everyone who follows God can be ready and have everything they need to do every good work."


THE STORY OF THE GOSPEL
