Family Discussion Starters:

- ·What is one thing you remember from this week's Bible story?
- ·Where did Rahab hide the two Israelite men?
- · Why do you think Rahab wanted to help the Israelites?
- · How do we become part of God's family?

Family Activities:

- •Tie a thick, red ribbon in a window at the front of your home. As you notice the ribbon each day, remind your kids that Rahab trusted in God and became part of God's special people, the Israelites. Mention that Rahab was part of Jesus' family (Matthew 1:5). Remind kids that we become part of God's family when we trust in Jesus.
- Walk your neighborhood as a family seven times during the week. As you walk, pray for your neighbors to trust in Jesus. Pray God would give your family opportunities to tell your neighbors the good news about Jesus.
