



BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Joshua gathered the Israelites together to remind them of how God had helped them.
- Joshua told the people to obey God and trust Him.
- Joshua challenged the people to worship only God.
- The people promised they would only worship God.
- Joshua set up a large stone to remind the people of their promise.

CHRIST CONNECTION:

Before Joshua died, he left the Israelites with a task: obey God. After Jesus' death and resurrection, Jesus appeared to His disciples and left them with a task: obey Him by telling others about Him.

KEY PASSAGE: Psalm 77:14
