BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Joshua knew he was old and would die soon, but he wanted the people to always obey God.
- Starting with Abraham,
 Joshua reminded the Israelites
 of all the wonderful things
 God had done for them.
- Joshua warned them that God would allow their enemies to rule over them if they dishonored Him.
- The people agreed that they would worship only God.

CHRIST CONNECTION:

As Joshua prepared for his own death, he left behind a legacy of obedience to God. After Jesus' death and resurrection, He appeared to the disciples and left them with a legacy: to obey Him by making disciples of all nations.

KEY PASSAGE: Psalm 77:14

What is a miracle? A miracle is something God does that usually cannot be done so that we can know He is all-powerful.
