BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Naomi's husbands and two sons died in Moab.
- Naomi and her son's wife Ruth moved back to Naomi's home in Judah.
- Boaz saw Ruth gathering grain in his field and made sure she was safe and had food.
- Boaz was a family redeemer for Naomi's family.
- Boaz married Ruth, and they had a baby boy named Obed.
- Obed was the grandfather of King David.

CHRIST CONNECTION:

Boaz was a family redeemer. He helped his family. Jesus is our Redeemer. Jesus helps us by saving us from our sin.

KEY PASSAGE PHRASE:

God gives life forever.

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

What is the punishment for sin? The punishment for sin is separation from God.

Family Discussion Starters:

- What is one thing you remember from this week's Bible story?

- Ask a church leader if there is someone in your church family who could use help with tasks such as grocery shopping, yard work, or caregiving. As your family serves this person, remind children that Boaz was a family redeemer who helped his family. Members of the family of God help one another.
- Offer to babysit for a family with a baby this week. As your family cares for the baby, talk about how Boaz and Ruth had a baby boy named Obed. Obed grew up to be the grandfather of King David. Ruth was part of Jesus' family.
