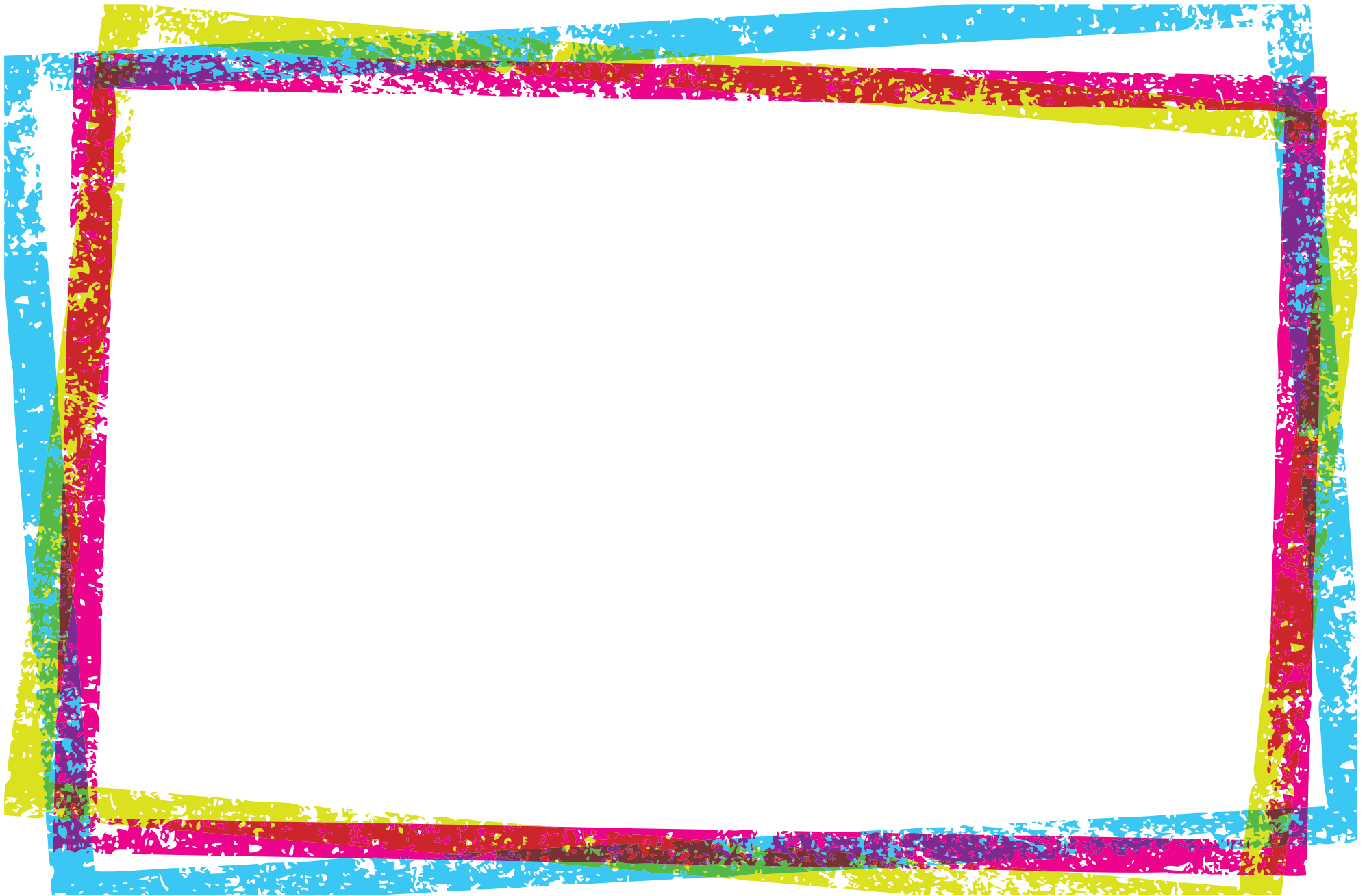

## God Provided for Hannah

### BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- A woman named Hannah was sad because she could not have children.
- She asked God for a son and promised to dedicate him to the Lord.
- God gave Hannah a son—named Samuel—and Hannah brought him to the tabernacle to serve the Lord.
- God called Samuel and gave him messages for Israel.

### CHRIST CONNECTION:

Hannah trusted God and sent Samuel away from home to serve God with his whole life. God sent Jesus from heaven to earth to be our Savior. Just as Samuel used God's words to tell people about God, Jesus—the Word who became flesh—perfectly shows us what God is like.
