BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Paul, a follower of Jesus, wrote a letter to Christians in Ephesus.
- Paul explained that everyone starts out dead in sin.
- No amount of good deeds can save us, because we are dead in sin.
- God sent His Son, Jesus, to save us.
- Because of Jesus death and resurrection, we can be alive in Him.

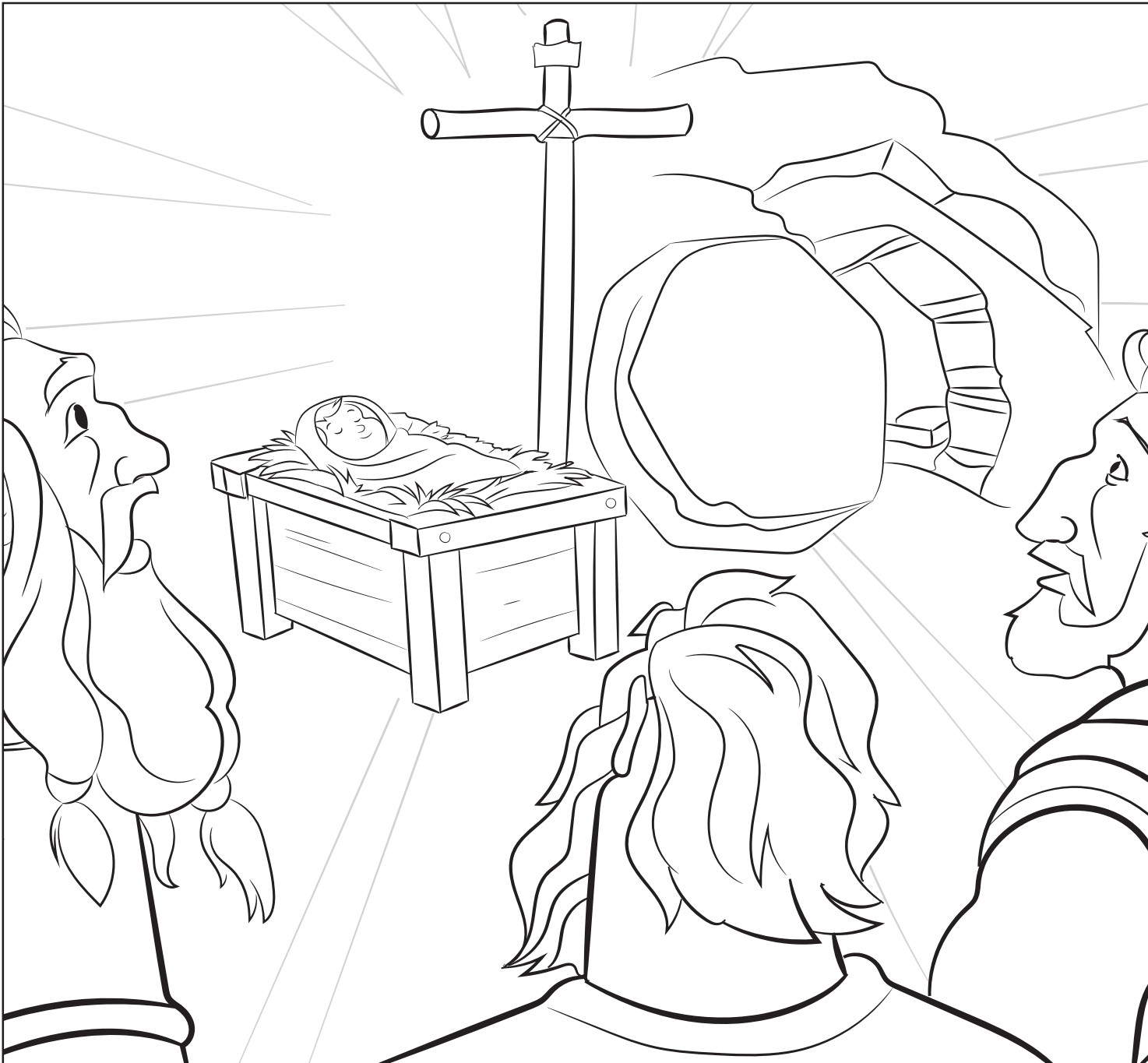
CHRIST CONNECTION:

God takes sin seriously. People deserve to die for their sins, but God loves us and sent His Son, Jesus, to defeat death by dying on the cross for our sins and rising from the dead. Everyone who trusts in Jesus has eternal life.

KEY PASSAGE: Romans 6:23

Family Discussion Starters:

- What are some ways God changes people when they put their faith in Jesus?
- What is “spiritual death”? What is “spiritual life”?
- How and why does God save people from sin?

Family Activity:

Work with your family to design and build a contraption that will protect an egg dropped from a height. Talk to your kids about the difference between the consequences of sin (which believers often face) and the punishment of sin (which Jesus saves us from).
