August 15th is the Feast of the Assumption of Mary into Heaven. At the end of Mary's time on earth, Mary was taken into Heaven, body and soul, because of her Immaculate Conception (being conceived without the stain of Original Sin) and her YES to God to bring Jesus into the world.

Did you know? The Church teaches that Mary is the only person in Heaven with a body other than Jesus (but we'll get ours back at the end of time).
