Dear Families,

Sunday, December 3rd marks the start of Advent and a new year in the Catholic Church. In the season of Advent, we prepare our hearts and homes for the birth of Jesus on Christmas. We wait in joy, hope and anticipation for Christ, the Light of the World that will fill our hearts and renew our spirits. One common tradition of our Catholic faith is the Advent Wreath. In Church, families take turns lighting the candles on the Advent Wreath before the start of each weekend Mass. At home, families can light the candles on their own Advent Wreath each week while praying and reflecting daily during Advent. However your family prepares this Advent season, may your focus be on Jesus Christ!

Don't forget to submit your Mass and Explore 4 reflections! As a friendly reminder, children in grades 1 - 8 are expected to complete seven Mass and four Explore 4 reflections each year. Attending Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation are expected of all Catholics, as it stands as the first precept of our Church. Please submit these promptly to ensure your children experience and appreciate the Mass and our Catholic Community to the fullest.




