

FROM OUR SENIOR PASTOR....

In 1940, hundreds of thousands of Allied soldiers were stranded on the beaches of Dunkirk. They were completely surrounded, helpless, and waiting for destruction. The British Navy tried to evacuate them, but their large warships couldn't get close enough to the shallow beaches. That's when something remarkable happened. Ordinary people stepped in. Fishermen, ferry captains, yacht owners—even families with small boats—set sail across the English Channel. Over 800 civilian vessels joined the Navy. Together, at great risk, they rescued more than 300,000 men. It wasn't the work of one hero, but a team of ordinary people, sacrificing together for those who could not save themselves. And that's exactly the picture of the church—God calls us, ordinary people, to work together, to pray together, to go to the lost together, and to sacrifice so that others may be rescued.

Here are a few ways you can help reach others with the gospel:

- 1. Get trained in how to share the gospel and your testimony. We are about to wrap up our first 3 Circles training group. If you want to join the next one, let me know. It's six weeks of training that will help you turn everyday conversations into gospel conversations.
- 2. Pray for the lost together in your small groups, families, or other groups you may be a part of. We are fighting spiritual battles for the souls of people (2 Cor. 4:4). The Bible and prayer are our weapons (Eph. 6:17-19).
- 3. Plan on being a part of the team for our annual Trunk-or-Treat. We will have over 1,000 people on campus, and no one should leave without hearing the gospel. October 29, 5:30-7 PM. Sign up to help. Bring candy. Pray constantly. And get ready to share the gospel boldly.
