ASH WED

WEEK TWO

Take time with the Gospel this week to imagine yourself in the scene a little at a time. Consider using the strategy shared with Habit #2 (Read. Reflect. Respond. Rest.)

Revisit Habit #3 this week in order to make a good confession.
