GIVE your life to Jesus

No one is a disciple by accident. It is a decisive choice requiring radical commitment of our life and everything associated with it. We won't do it perfectly. Every day we must recommit ourselves to this choice. It's a good thing we already cultivated the habit of repenting and believing! We can always start anew. Full conversion will take a lifetime but the journey starts with an initial "YES!"

Habit 9



GIVE your life to Jesus





Are you ready to fully entrust your life to Jesus? Are you ready to make Him the center and focal point of your life? Are you ready to say YES to Him fully and completely?

IF YES: Tell Him. Create a small prayer of surrender and trust. Repeat it every morning and every night. Say it when the journey gets hard.

For example: "Jesus I am yours." "Jesus, I give myself to you completely." "Jesus, take all of me."

Examine the structure of your life. Are there things that need to be shifted, added, or removed to reflect this new focus of your life?

IF NO: What do you think is holding you back? Talk to Jesus about this and ask Him to transform it. Reach out to a trusted friend or spiritual advisor to walk with you.
