## // Discussion Questions

- 1. What are some examples of truths that might feel correct but might not be aligned with God's truth? Reflect on a time when you believed something to be true that later turned out to be false. How did that experience affect your decisions or relationships?
- 2. Jim pointed out that addictions often reflects deeper issues rather than the substance itself. Consider a challenge or struggle in your own life. What deeper emotions or pressures do you think are contributing to that challenge or struggle?
- **3.** Jim mentioned the Biblical concept of depravity, stating that it doesn't mean we are totally bad, but rather in need of God's help. How does acknowledging our own brokenness change how we view God, ourselves, and others? How can understanding your brokenness help you connect with God or others who are struggling or feeling isolated?
- **4.** Why is it sometimes necessary to take a step back from someone you love? Can you think of a time when you had to let someone make their own choices, even if it was hard for you? How did that experience change your relationship with them?
- **5.** Think about a situation where you wanted to help someone but felt helpless. How can accepting that you cannot control everything change how you respond to that situation?
