// **Bible References:** Matt 22:36-40; 1 John 4:20; John 13:34-35

// **Community Question:** Share the name your favorite love song and why you “love” it.

### // **Discussion Questions**

1. Jesus said the greatest commandment is to love God and the second is like it: to love others. Why do you think Jesus tied these two commands together so tightly? What does that tell us about how we should express our faith?
2. Jim said, “There’s someone in your life who needs to be reassured that you love them.” Who comes to mind for you, and what might it look like to intentionally love them this week, not with words, but with action?
3. **Going Deeper:** Jesus said, “*Just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another.*” (John 13:34) That raises a powerful question; *How has Jesus loved me?* Take a minute to reflect on that. What comes to mind when you think about how Jesus has shown you love...through grace, forgiveness, sacrifice, or presence?

As a group, talk about how understanding **Jesus’ love for you personally** could reshape the way you show love to others...especially the difficult or distant people in your life. What would change if we loved like that, at home, at work, or in this group?

// **Challenge:** As a group, how can we live out this “Summer of Love” together? Is there a need in our church, community, or someone in our circle we could serve as a team? Let’s plan to do something together that shows the love of Jesus in a real, tangible way.
