

**Free from Sin to Grow in Grace
Session 15 Handout**

Romans 8:1-9 TPT

verses 7-9 - In fact, the mind-set focused on the flesh fights God's plan and refuses to submit to his direction, because it cannot! 8 For no matter how hard they try, God finds no pleasure with those who are controlled by the flesh. 9 But when the Spirit of Christ empowers your life, you are not dominated by the flesh but by the Spirit. And if you are not joined to the Spirit of the Anointed One, you are not of him.

The KJV states in verse 7: **Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not SUBJECT to the law of God, neither indeed can it be.**

Subject – G5293 – *hupotasso*

- I. To arrange under, to subordinate
- II. To subject, put in subjection
- III. To subject oneself, obey
- IV. To _____ to one's _____
- V. To yield to one's admonition or advice
- VI. To obey, be subject

This word was a Greek military term meaning ***“to arrange [troop divisions] in a military fashion under the command of a leader.”*** In non-military use, it was “a voluntary attitude of giving in, cooperating, assuming responsibility, and carrying a burden.” ***He is saying, “Such a mind is not marshalled under the command of God, but of Satan.”***

James 4:7 NKJV - Therefore, submit (subject) to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

KJV 9 – But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.

Dwell – G3611 – *oikeo*

To _____ a house, i.e. reside (figuratively, _____, remain, inhere); by implication, to cohabit. The verb therefore means “to live or dwell in a certain place as your home.”

Romans 8:10-11 TPT

Now Christ lives His life in you! And even though your body may be dead because of the effects of sin, His life-giving Spirit imparts life to you because you are fully accepted by God. 11 Yes, God raised Jesus to life! And since God's Spirit of Resurrection lives in you, He will also raise your dying body to life by the same Spirit that breathes life into you!

James 4:5-8 TPT

5 Does the Scripture mean nothing to you that says, “The Spirit that God breathed into our hearts is a jealous Lover who intensely desires to have more and more of us”? 6 But He continues to pour out more and more grace upon us. For it says, God resists you when you are proud but continually pours out grace when you are humble.”

7 So then, surrender to God. Stand up to the devil and resist him and he will turn and run away from you. 8 Move your heart closer and closer to God, and He will come even closer to you.
