1. **Pneuma**: "spirit"
2. **Pneumatikos**: "spirit-controlled"
3. **Psuche**: "soul"
4. **Psuchikos**: "soul-controlled"
5. **Zoe**: "God's life"
6. **Logos**: "word, logic, understanding"
7. **Aletheia**: "truth"

1. _____

The Greek word for the human "spirit," *pneuma*, is the same word used for the Holy Spirit. It is also the word for "*breath*." The Spirit is the part of our being that is godlike, or as the Word says, was made in His "likeness." Our Spirit is where Jesus lives.

Thus, our spirit is the part of us that God _____ to _____ with or relate to Him; not only Him but also the entire spiritual realm. It shouldn't be surprising then, to know it houses our conscience and intuition.

Spirit and soul are not one in the same. The Greek word for soul is "*psuche*." The psyche, or "*psuche*," is the mind, emotions, and will. Let's break it down more:

- ❖ **The mind** – or intellect; reasons, thinks, forms, logic, processes, and stores information
- ❖ **The emotions** – allows us to feel, care, warn, and relate
- ❖ **The will** – or volition, based on what we've put into our mind and emotions, makes the decisions—the will determines our course of action.

The soul is the processing mechanism, the computer mainframe, the translator. It is important to realize that the soul is NOT the part of us God intended to connect or communicate with directly.

Its function was not to control or lead us, but to _____,
from where God dwelled and communicated with us. Our spirit was to receive from Him and pass on the information to the soul, which would then process the information and store it.

Aletheia – literally means “*the reality that existed in the original norm*” or “*the reality lying at the basis or essence of something*.” “*Altethia*” is true and genuine reality. “Unconcealed” facts are not truth

There is no truth without God, since He created all reality. He is the basis for everything, the Originator.

Why is this important? If man denies that standard, or that norm reality, then eventually the bar gets lowered to the point where it is denied as even existing. But truth does exist and can be summarized as the absolute standard, found in God, from which all wisdom, logic, and knowledge proceed. It has always existed in God, and it never changes.

God, the Creator of all, is the Originator of truth; He reigns in Truth; and Truth is birthed through Him. This is CRITICAL to our journey because Jesus said that knowing the Truth would set us free. No truth; no freedom.
