The Father sent His Son for this very purpose: to show us relationship.

From the moment Jesus was born, and throughout the next 33 and half years, Jesus was showing us the Father's heart. He is also inviting us to live and enjoy Him to experience the same life He has with the Father...relationally. Notice the language in the following scriptures:
