Shared Objectives: Together with conference superintendents, Connecting Church leaders and other identified staff Vitality Specialists seek to:

- Support churches and hubs in meeting the goal of 100% vitality (deepening discipleship, seeing all the people, living and loving like Jesus and multiplying impact) under the guidance of the Holy Spirit;
- Participate in discernment of congregational and community needs as aligned with Missional Action Planning (MAP); and
- Meet common and emerging needs through a centralized pool of resources (tools, pathways, academies, etc.) and resourcers (facilitation, consultation, coaching, property redevelopment, etc.).

Position Activities:

- Facilitate vitality conversations with local churches;
- Attend and facilitate as requested at least one hub meeting/year for each hub in assigned districts;
- Meet monthly with other Vitality Specialists and Conference Superintendents to share, strategize and coordinate;
- Develop centralized resources informed by local church and hub needs; and
- Provide programmatic support and consultation in specific expertise areas for the conference
