0. Opened with prayer.
1. Approval of Minutes from May.
2. Financial report from Manette.
  - a. May income of 86 k\$ against expenses of 100 k\$.
  - b. In review of 2024 budget, some Campus expenses belonged under the Major Maintenance account. Sewer system and bathroom repair, BEC alarm system update.
  - c. 106 k\$ total spend on courtyard playground
  - d. Bank account balances and investments were shared.
3. Wardens' reports. Jr warden spoke to campus maintenance: fence in back 40, dead tree removed, breezeway repairs holding up so far (thanks Barry et al.)
4. Marilyn Patterson introduced idea of making VOD two shifts.
5. Rector's report and discussion
  - a. Good handover with Alvaro. Happy for him. Fr Alvaro blessed St Dunstan's with a good start on the Spanish-language service and community outreach. Brought connection to Nacer de Nuevo, etc
  - b. Encouragement on continuity of parishioners. Jonas is on-board for soccer and more. Lots happening with that community.
  - c. Made an offer to Fr Naty who accepted Associate Rector position – to start July 1.
