0. Opened with prayer.
1. Approval of Minutes from October.
2. Financial report from Manette.
 - a. Oct income of 70 k\$ versus expenses of 99 k\$.
 - b. Now 72 k\$ behind straight-line budget, but most expenses are past while Xmas Eve is approaching. We have backstop income and budget owners expected to adjust if needed towards year-end.
 - c. Following input from parishioner, ~55k\$ of October income reclassified as Capital Campaign donation, so net gain of 15 k\$ versus Oct reporting.
 - d. Banks has some reporting aids that help.
 - e. Pledges are behind versus last year: 89 pledges for 614 k\$ at time of Nov-15 mtg.
 - f. ~500 k\$ of the "Strong Roots" campaign receipts are invested to generate ongoing returns before expenses come in.
3. Sr Warden acknowledged the work of nominating 5 candidates for vestry election in January. Also the EDOT Diocesan Council meeting is approaching in February.
4. Jr Warden spoke to leaks in office space and in roofing over porte cochere. Cleaning up fallen branches.
5. Rector's report and discussion
 - a. Keep Father Naty in our prayers. Eye required second surgery and may not have been totally successful. Fr Naty to recover for 1 month in OK City.
 - b. Steve Ferguson to do lots of pastoral care and some preaching. Jaime Muñoz to lead a Morning Prayer (with reserved Communion) and plan Our Lady of Guadalupe (Dec 14).
 - c. Thanks offered for the musicians who help lead us in Sunday worship –
*I can feel the brush of Angels' wings, I see glory on each face.
Surely the presence... of the Lord... is in this place.*
 - d. Thanks offered for Dede and Manette.
 - e. Thanks offered for Angela Stengl leading IHS (In His Steps) this season.
 - f. Encouraged us to read this week's blog and re-hear Sunday's sermon.
 - g. Discussion over protocol when homeless pass through campus: inform Dede, work to avoid accosting parishioners, and use HOT team (police) to assist as appropriate.
