ANOINTING OF THE SICK

The Catechism of the Catholic Church (#1514-1515) teaches that this sacrament is not only for those at the point of death, but for anyone seriously ill or facing serious surgery. In fact, it is preferred that parishioners entering the hospital for surgery should ask the priest for this sacrament before being admitted. Parishioners should never wait until the last minute to call. We encourage parishioners facing surgery to let the parish priest know of their condition before entering the hospital so that they can be anointed before admission.

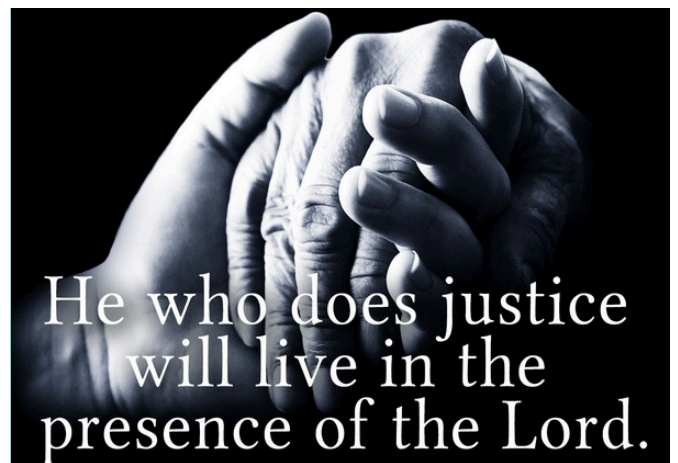

Shepherd's Corner

I am the good shepherd, and I know mine and mine know me

In our first reading, we are told of the Lord and two angels, who appear to Abraham in the form of three strangers. Abraham doesn't know it's the Lord and his angels, but because of the cultural values of hospitality in the Middle East, he invited them in for something to eat. The kindnesses that Abraham and his wife Sarah showed to these strangers is also reflected in a quote from Paul's letter to the Hebrews; "Do not neglect hospitality, for through it some have unknowingly entertained angels" (Hebrews 13:2).

Memories from my past remind me of how hospitality can make an impact on someone. Once, my brother (who lived in Minneapolis at the time) brought a friend with him when he came home for a summer visit. A few weeks after he left, he called and told my mom that, on the drive back to Minnesota, his friend couldn't stop raving about how my mother was so attentive in making sure he always had something to eat or drink, and how comfortable she made him feel. That memory has stuck with me for well over 50 years. (But some memories aren't quite as clear; for example, I remember the story of the impact my mother made on this person, but I can't recall his name. Sigh, just another thing to remind me that I'm getting older.)

There was also a pivotal time in my life when hospitality directly affected me. It was when I was discerning a call to the priesthood. I looked at priesthood within the Diocese of Toledo as well as a few other religious communities. While these various communities were nice, I still didn't feel like I should commit to any one of them. Then, I was invited to the Franciscan community for a weekend at their house of studies in Washington, D.C. I drove from Toledo to D.C., but due to a snowstorm in Ohio and Pennsylvania, I knew I wouldn't arrive on time. Now, this was before the age of cell phones. So, knowing I would be late, I stopped at a gas station to use a payphone to call and say I was still coming, but didn't know what time I would arrive. I'm sure I was frustrated and embarrassed to arrive late. I knew that they had expected me for dinner and that the meetings with prospective vocations would have already started. When I finally arrived about 2½ hours late, the door was opened, and Fr. Chris greeted me warmly and introduced himself. He took me down to the dining area and sat with me while I had dinner. After showing me where I would sleep, he invited me to gather with the other men who were there for the weekend. Later, when I was contemplating a decision, I remembered how hospitable the Franciscans were. Instead of making me feel that I was late and disrupting their schedule, they made me feel welcome. (Unfortunately, this wouldn't be the only time I was late with the friars. I was late when entering the community because my house didn't immediately sell, and something happened that caused my first vows to be postponed by a week! This was all brought up again when a friar preached my first Mass.)

All in all, these events are hardly newsworthy. Yet, I recount them as they made an impression on me. It reminds me that this is what Jesus has asked us to do: put God first and others second. That's hard to remember when we're bombarded by the ideals of the world that seems to continuously say, "put yourself first."

For many people, these last weeks of summer may offer opportunities to gather with family and friends. Perhaps we can ask ourselves if our behavior in these gatherings says we are more other-centered or more self-centered? Do people see us as images of Christ ... or are we simply reflections of the world's values?

Are you struggling with the loss of someone you love? We have two opportunities coming up to offer help and encouragement after the death of a spouse, child, family member, or friend.

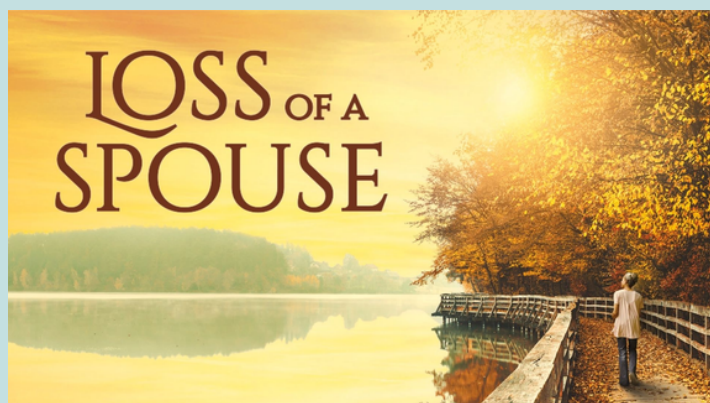
