### ANOINTING OF THE SICK

The Catechism of the Catholic Church (#1514-1515) teaches that this sacrament is not only for those at the point of death, but for anyone seriously ill or facing serious surgery. In fact, it is preferred that parishioners entering the hospital for surgery should ask the priest for this sacrament before being admitted. Parishioners should never wait until the last minute to call. We encourage parishioners facing surgery to let the parish priest know of their condition before entering the hospital so that they can be anointed before admission.





I am the good shepherd, and I know mine and mine know me

Well, it's the last weekend in May, a month dedicated to our Blessed Mother, and I wanted to share the drawing that graces the front cover of our bulletin. I happened to be at a meeting at Holy Trinity Catholic School, and I noticed this picture hanging in the hallway. I was told it was drawn by a first grader who happens to be one of our parishioners. Let me say that this first grader didn't trace it, but she drew it freehand! I am totally impressed by what the art teacher can bring out in these kids. When I was her age, I had a hard time just coloring within the lines. Great job, Blair.

I wonder if on the last day of school, the children sing that old ditty... "School's out, school's out. Teacher let the monkeys out..." The way things are going lately, they are probably discouraged from singing it. I'm sure there are those who think that alluding to the antics of children and calling them monkeys may seem demeaning or politically incorrect. Heck, at another church, I had a parent complain that I called the students "kids," because they said that kids are baby goats and their child was a person. Oh, so often I long for the good old days... but were they really better? I often have to remind myself that looking backward keeps me from looking ahead at the possibilities to come.

But one thing hasn't changed. This weekend, we celebrate Memorial Day; a time many people get together for picnics and family gatherings. While it is good to nurture the relationships between friends and family, we can't forget the real reason we celebrate Memorial Day. On this day, we are asked to remember the people who gave their lives so that we can experience the freedoms we have in the United States of America. Too often, we focus on all the negative things happening in our country and forget how blessed we truly are. Our freedom is often taken for granted, so on this day we pause to reflect and remember.

When I was privileged to go to the National Cemetery in Normandy, I met a young couple from France who were walking with their two children through the cemetery. I don't know how the conversation started, but they told me they bring their children to the cemetery a few times a year to remind them of the sacrifices others made for them to have the freedom they experience. So, while I'm not a parent, if there's a way to talk to your children about why we celebrate Memorial Day, I'd encourage you in some way to do so.

God of power and mercy,
you destroy war and put down earthly pride.
Banish violence from our midst and wipe away our tears,
that we may all deserve to be called your sons and daughters.
Keep in your mercy those men and women
who have died in the cause of freedom
and bring them safely
into your kingdom of justice and peace.

# What is Memorial Day?

Originally called Decoration Day, Memorial Day is a day of remembrance for those who have lost their lives in our nation's service. Though some form of Memorial Day has been celebrated in various areas of the country beforehand, Memorial Day was officially proclaimed by General John Logan on May 5, 1868 and was observed later that month on May 30 when flowers were placed on the graves of both Union and Confederate soldiers who were buried at Arlington Cemetery.




