ANOINTING OF THE SICK

The Catechism of the Catholic Church (#1514-1515) teaches that this sacrament is not only for those at the point of death, but for anyone seriously ill or facing serious surgery. In fact, it is preferred that parishioners entering the hospital for surgery should ask the priest for this sacrament before being admitted. Parishioners should never wait until the last minute to call. We encourage parishioners facing surgery to let the parish priest know of their condition before entering the hospital so that they can be anointed before admission.

Shepherd's Corner

I am the good shepherd, and I know mine and mine know me

Many people don't spend a lot of time reading the Old Testament. I think it's easier to look at the parables and the miracles of Jesus than to hear some of the Old Testament names. Heck, when was the last time you heard anyone named Amminadab, Asaph, or Zadok? While we can relate more to the New Testament and the parables and miracles of Jesus, the Old Testament holds stories that can capture our imagination: Jonah and the whale, Noah and the Ark, and the story of Adam and Eve, to name a few. But there is something in the story we hear today in our first reading from 2 Kings 5:14-17 that I like, though we only hear the last part of this story.

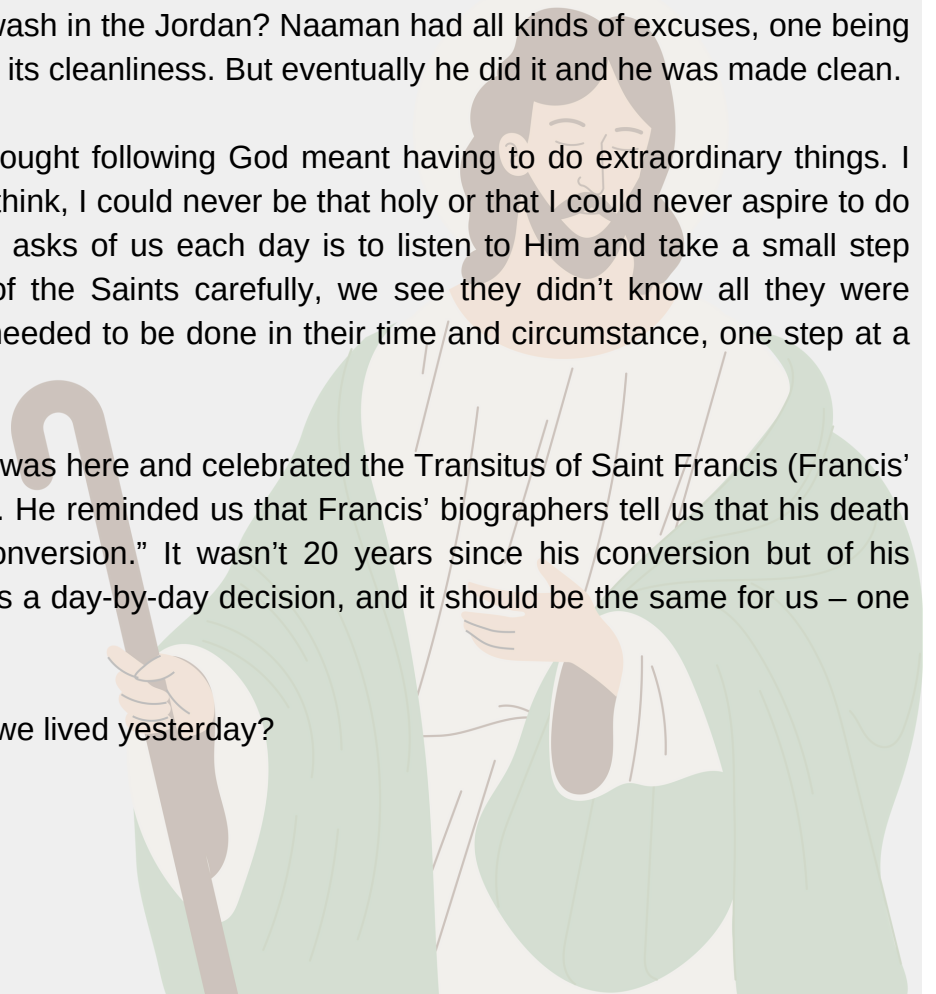
Naaman is a Syrian, a non-Jewish person. He is a commander of the king's army, which was a highly favored position. However, he has been diagnosed with leprosy. A Hebrew slave girl of his wife suggested he go and visit the prophet, Elisha. He took the advice and made his way to Israel to be cured. When Elisha saw him, he simply told Naaman to wash in the Jordan seven times and "you will be clean" (2 Kings 5:10). Naaman grew angry. He wanted Elisha to do something magical, like move his hand over the leprosy or utter an incantation. But Elisha only says for him to wash seven times in the Jordan. Naaman was preparing to leave in a huff because Elisha didn't do things like he thought he should. But his servants said to him, if Elisha asked you to do something extraordinary, you would have done it. So why don't you just go and wash in the Jordan? Naaman had all kinds of excuses, one being that the Jordan river was not known for its cleanliness. But eventually he did it and he was made clean.

I like this story because, at times, I thought following God meant having to do extraordinary things. I would read the lives of the Saints and think, I could never be that holy or that I could never aspire to do the great things they did. Yet, all God asks of us each day is to listen to Him and take a small step closer to Him. If you read the lives of the Saints carefully, we see they didn't know all they were accomplishing. They simply did what needed to be done in their time and circumstance, one step at a time.

On October 3, Fr. Peter Lyons, T.O.R. was here and celebrated the Transitus of Saint Francis (Francis' transition from earthly to heavenly life). He reminded us that Francis' biographers tell us that his death happened "in the 20th year of his conversion." It wasn't 20 years since his conversion but of his conversion. Conversion for Francis was a day-by-day decision, and it should be the same for us – one step at a time.

Are we willing to live today better than we lived yesterday?

Honduras Awareness Weekend

In 2008, Good Shepherd Catholic Community established a covenant partnership with the Fray Casimiro Cypher Technical & Professional Institute (formerly known as the Trade School) in Campamento, Honduras. Our covenant vision enables Good Shepherd and the Institute to work together to help the poor of the community and promote social justice. Through our work with these schools, we strive to help the people we serve in Honduras to find a productive and safe life in their country.

As the Church celebrates World Missions this month, we would like to take this opportunity to bring awareness of our partnership by sharing achievements of the program and goals for the year ahead.

OUR MISSION IMPACT IN HONDURAS

EDUCATION IS OUR #1 PRIORITY!

- We support the education of 90 students at the bilingual school and 500+ at the Technical Institute
- 100 scholarships provided to students in both schools
- Financial support provided to subsidize teachers' salaries, textbooks, and uniforms
- We support the Religious Education Program and Health & Wellness Program
- Housing and enhanced living conditions provided to 14 boarding students at the Fr. Ronald Mohnickey dormitories
- Tutors read virtually to students in grades 2-9 every week
- Approximately 90 students will graduate at the end of this school year
- Facilities and Program Updates
- Construction of the Father Richard Eldredge Technology Multipurpose Room is complete. It provides a great space for virtual tutoring sessions and staff meetings. It is also used as a lecture room and a small observatory.
- Through our Religious Education program, sacrament preparation classes are now being offered on campus. Funding has been provided to promote a pastoral youth group and an expansion of the chapel has been completed.



2025-2026 GOALS

- Focus on the implementation of the Advanced Education Program, which aims to ensure participants have access to opportunities for personal and professional development of academic, technical and business skills, by:
- Improving workshop spaces and equipment
- Expanding the technical skills program to achieve an intermediate level
- Offering computer classes to improve academic and business administration skills
- Offer a new scholarship program for students interested in higher health education, such as nursing and lab technicians
- Research the development of a program for students interested in starting their own small business after graduation

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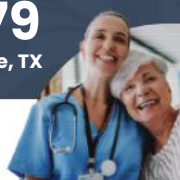
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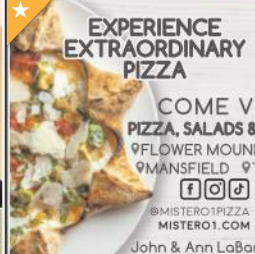
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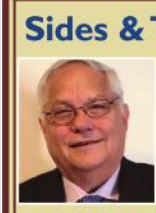
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
