ANOINTING OF THE SICK

The Catechism of the Catholic Church (#1514-1515) teaches that this sacrament is not only for those at the point of death, but for anyone seriously ill or facing serious surgery. In fact, it is preferred that parishioners entering the hospital for surgery should ask the priest for this sacrament before being admitted. Parishioners should never wait until the last minute to call. We encourage parishioners facing surgery to let the parish priest know of their condition before entering the hospital so that they can be anointed before admission.

Shepherd's Corner

I am the good shepherd, and I know mine and mine know me

"If you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would obey you." (Luke 17:6) I remember hearing this gospel from a young age and testing it out to see how much faith I had. I would go in my backyard and tell the silver maple we had to move from one spot to another. I was shocked and surprised when nothing happened. I thought to myself, maybe it's like *Jack and the Beanstalk* and I had to give it time to move overnight. So, I went to bed, and, to my dismay, the maple tree was still in our backyard. Perhaps I didn't have as much faith as I thought I did. Or perhaps the roots were too deep and anchored into the ground, so instead I started smaller. I tried to move a small bush (no luck) and then a leaf that had fallen from a tree. Nothing. Did this mean that I didn't have faith? Did this mean that Jesus' words weren't true?

Now I see that what I was doing wasn't faith. Faith isn't trying to manipulate God. Faith isn't about doing what I want or making what I wish for happen. Faith is trust in God and trying to see how He sees things. Of course, there is nothing wrong with praying for things we need or want. In fact, we are told to seek and knock. But faith is trust that God will answer our prayers because He loves us and wants only the best for us.

The prophet Habakkuk in our first reading knew that, though it may seem that he voices a prayer similar to what many of us voice today. He says, "How long, O LORD? I cry for help, but you do not listen!" (Hab 1:2) Does this sound somewhat familiar? Sure, we may change the words a bit. We may ask why there is war, poverty, injustices. Why am I suffering from this illness? Like the prophet, we see the evil and hardships of this world and we send up our laments and/or complaints to God. But I think the difference is that Habakkuk goes on to say that he will simply wait and see how God will answer. He is willing to wait, but I'm not sure we do waiting all that well.

Faith is saying, "I don't understand, but I trust You will make good come out of this." Of course, I'm not talking about sitting around and letting God do all the work. We have to do our part in our world. But I do tend to think we are not very patient people when we have to wait on something. And modern technology doesn't help. I remember when the microwave oven came out and people were amazed at how fast it cooked. Now, I stand in front of the microwave and say, "What do you mean I have to wait 3 minutes and 30 seconds to make popcorn! I'm hungry now!" But I digress.

I think Habakkuk understood that, although he saw the violence around him, he also saw that God was faithful to His people throughout history. The question was which event was going to capture and hold his attention. Would he remain focused on the negative things he saw, or would he focus on and promote the faithfulness of God?

We have all been given the gift of faith. That's why we gather together as community. We don't try to manipulate God by our prayers or Mass attendance. Rather, by putting ourselves in His presence, we encourage ourselves and others to remember the faithfulness and love of God. Faith, even the size of a mustard seed, helps us get through those times when we don't see things as God sees them. May our faith and patience allow us to let God work in His own time and to trust that His will (not ours) will be done. Now, off to stand in front of the microwave and to wait (patiently) for the corn to stop popping!




