## ANOINTING OF THE SICK

The Catechism of the Catholic Church (#1514-1515) teaches that this sacrament is not only for those at the point of death, but for anyone seriously ill or facing serious surgery. In fact, it is preferred that parishioners entering the hospital for surgery should ask the priest for this sacrament before being admitted. Parishioners should never wait until the last minute to call. We encourage parishioners facing surgery to let the parish priest know of their condition before entering the hospital so that they can be anointed before admission.

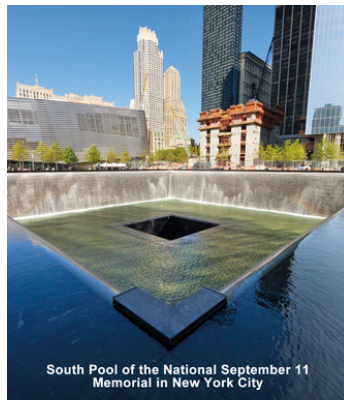

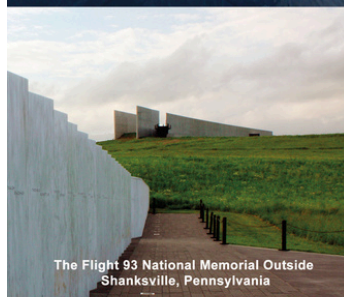

# Shepherd's Corner

I am the good shepherd, and I know mine and mine know me

Where did the summer go? Labor Day has come and gone. For anyone from the northeastern part of the United States, it was Labor Day that marked the last hurrah of the summer season. As a child, I didn't look forward to Labor Day. Not that I didn't enjoy the picnics with my cousins, but Labor Day also marked the beginning of a new school year. Now, I enjoyed going to school. What I didn't enjoy was not being allowed to stay up late, as I'd have to get up early in order to catch the bus. I never was a "morning person" and I'm still not — just ask anyone on the office staff.

But as I was thinking of Labor Day, two memories from my childhood came to mind. One was a question I would ask my mother: "Why can't I wear white after Labor Day?" (It's a moot point for me now since I wear a black habit...but I can still hear my mother's voice if I tried to wear my white shoes or white belt after Labor Day.) As much as I would ask her, "why?" I don't think I was ever given a satisfactory answer. But, now that we have Google, I learned that during the *Gilded Age* (late 1870s through the 1890s) the elite in society would wear white during summer and go to the shore. Upon arriving back to the city after Labor Day, their white outfits were packed away until next summer. This fashion trend caught on even with the lower social classes. While I know you can't believe everything you read on the internet, that answer satisfies me.

While the fashion trend of not wearing white after Labor Day seems irrelevant today, it had me thinking that our world has lost some of its sense of decorum; not just in fashion but in an overall sense of respect or the way we present ourselves. It's easy to do or say things without thinking it through. We don't intentionally want to hurt someone, but a negative comment here or there can make an impact. For example, I hear people say that not everything they see on social media is always uplifting or family friendly. While it's nice to have a way to share information, are we too free with the things we put out there? (Full disclosure: I don't have social media, I hear confessions.)

While many things on social media are good, especially for family members who we don't see regularly, there is also a down side. Many people have told me of a lot of time being wasted scrolling on their phones instead of doing things with family, being productive at work, or spending time with God. Others have said there are things posted that inspire envy, jealousy, negative feelings towards others, as well as other things I won't mention in a bulletin column. Now I'm not saying to not post things, but I wonder if we ever thought that our posting may be a near occasion of sin for others? While some people may have to work on saying "no" to opening those Apps, perhaps we need to not share as freely as we do.

Wow, how did I go from wearing white after Labor Day to social media? That was quite a digression from my memories of Labor Day! Perhaps (and hopefully) it was the Holy Spirit and not simply a lapse in my thought process. Oh yeah, I said I had two memories of Labor Day. The other memory had to do with a piece of Bazooka bubble gum. I'm not sure they even make that gum anymore, but when you unwrapped it, the inner wrapping had a cartoon on it. There was one cartoon that is burned into my mind. "On what day were all babies born?" The answer... "on Labor Day." OK, I'll admit that as a child I didn't get the joke, but at least, this time, my mother was able to help me understand it.

## Our Grandparents

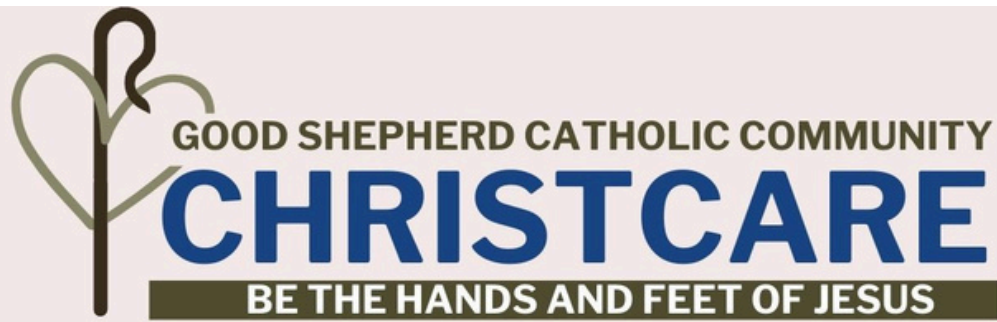
Lord Jesus,

### **What is ChristCare?**

- ChristCare is a Good Shepherd Outreach Ministry designed to give parishioners an opportunity to put Catholic Social Teaching into action as we walk alongside our neighbors who are asking for assistance and to afford the opportunity to invite those served into a discussion of their faith. The ministry provides financial assistance and other services, on a short term, one-time yearly basis, to low-income families who reside in our parish boundaries and neighboring communities.

### **July 2025 Activity**

- 29 families living in our service area were provided financial assistance – 10 with rent and 19 with utilities
- 23 families have at least one member of the family working, and every family has total income less than the poverty guidelines
- 24 families have small children living in the home
- 12 families who received SNAP benefits (Food Stamps) and 3 families receiving Disability or Social Security benefits
- 25 families received a bag of food
- Every family prayed with us, sometimes joining us or leading the prayer!

### **Recent success story:**

- Curtis, a single father asked us to help him with an electric bill. His only income is Social Security Disability and they have managed successfully until now. The family had a very high electric bill from a previous residence. They relocated and now the electricity bills are much more reasonable. Curtis is confident that because of our assistance his family will be out of this hole, and they will not need future help. It was a huge relief to Curtis and he was especially grateful for the opportunity to pray with us.

### **Every client is invited to pray with us.**

- For many, this is where it becomes very emotional. The release from the financial pressure is palpable. And through prayer the focus shifts to the comfort that only God can bring. Together we all recognize the light of Christ in each other.
