ANOINTING OF THE SICK

The Catechism of the Catholic Church (#1514-1515) teaches that this sacrament is not only for those at the point of death, but for anyone seriously ill or facing serious surgery. In fact, it is preferred that parishioners entering the hospital for surgery should ask the priest for this sacrament before being admitted. Parishioners should never wait until the last minute to call. We encourage parishioners facing surgery to let the parish priest know of their condition before entering the hospital so that they can be anointed before admission.



Shepherd's Corner

I am the good shepherd, and I know mine and mine know me

While there are many different things to focus on in our Gospel today, the sentence that I kept coming back to was: "The person who is trustworthy in very small matters is also trustworthy in great ones; and the person who is dishonest in very small matters is also dishonest in great ones." (Luke 16:10)

The second half of this sentence had me going down Memory Lane and made me recognize how our sins can affect others in ways we may not know. Too often, we think sin is something private between God and me, and we don't recognize how much sin really does impact our relationships with others.

My parents would often utter the following proverb: "Little pitchers have big ears." While I originally didn't understand that saying, I knew they were talking about me. Eventually, I grasped the meaning that young children overhear and comprehend more than adults realize. And that is a very true statement.

One day, our next-door neighbor came over to talk to my mother. I must have been in the same room because I heard their conversation. Our neighbor went to a wedding the previous weekend, and she was telling my mother of the fun she had seeing all their old friends. Later in the conversation, she made the comment that she hadn't removed the price tag from the dress she bought. Now that the wedding was over, she was going to return it to the store for a refund. I don't remember if I ever asked my mom about this or not, but I do remember recognizing that this was wrong.

Whether we like it or not, it's the small things we say and do that have an impact on others. I can proudly say that I've not done anything like that in my own life; buying something, using it, and then returning it for a refund when I was through. But what about other things I've done that have been a bad example for others? I know from personal experience that when I stopped going to church in my late teen years, I affected the faith of my friends. That's no exaggeration. They told me that when I stopped going, they stopped, too, because of my example.

Our words and actions can either reinforce our belief in the teachings of Christ or discredit them. What does our behavior say to others (and I'm not just talking of our children)? I think that, perhaps, we can fool ourselves to think we're only doing small, inconsequential things. But let's not deceive ourselves. We need to be trustworthy in small things so we will be trustworthy enough to reap the benefits of entering the kingdom of heaven.







Youth Ministry Fund Quarterly Update

We are so grateful to all who have contributed to the Youth Ministry Fund. This ministry fund directly supports our middle and high school students by making our retreats, mission trips, and events more affordable, allowing more students to take advantage of important opportunities to encounter Christ.

From Jorge Ochoa, Coordinator of High School Youth Ministry:

This summer, God's Spirit moved powerfully among our Good Shepherd teens. From mission fields to massive conferences, and soon to our parish retreat, our young people have been discovering what it means to be disciples in today's world, and the fruits are overflowing.

Mission in Rio Grande City

Sixteen of our high school students and seven adult chaperones traveled to Immaculate Conception Parish in Rio Grande City, Texas, where they led a weeklong evangelization camp for 45 middle and high school students. Hosted by the Benedictine Sisters of the Good Shepherd, our group immersed themselves in prayer, daily Mass, and service. One of the most moving moments was during Adoration, as Fr. Eduardo Ortega carried the Eucharist through the room, blessing each camper. Friendships were formed across communities, the hospitality of the parish was unforgettable, and our teens returned home eager to serve again.

Steubenville Lone Star

In July, our parish brought its largest-ever group — 56 teens and adults — to the Steubenville Lone Star youth conference. Our youth were deeply touched by the sacrament of Reconciliation, the witness of national speakers, and the power of Eucharistic Adoration. Many of them came home with renewed joy and a stronger sense of belonging in the Church.

YOU HAVE MADE!

From Madeleine Hill, Coordinator of Middle School Youth Ministry:

This summer, our middle schoolers had two powerful opportunities to encounter Christ: RADIATE and Abide. RADIATE, our summer retreat, invited students to step away from the busyness of daily life and rest in God's presence through talks, small group discussions, and intentional prayer. Abide brought students together for weekly nights of fellowship, prayer, and small group bible study, creating a space where faith felt relatable and alive. Together, these experiences gave our students both the joy of community and the depth of retreat, forming lasting memories and opening new doors for God to work in their hearts.

It was so meaningful to see how these experiences touched students personally. A highlight of RADIATE was being in Adoration with our students and seeing Christ encounter their hearts. One student reported back, saying he knew God's presence was truly there for the first time in his life!

Because of your generosity, our middle schoolers are not only discovering who Jesus is, but also learning what it means to follow Him in their everyday lives. Thank you for making this possible and for continuing to invest in the next generation of disciples.

This fund has and will continue to benefit many of our students, and we are so excited to continue to create offerings that draw the youth of our parish closer to our Lord.
