Welcome Guest Preacher Bill Wildhack

Rev. Bill Wildhack became Stated Clerk and Manager of Communications for the Presbytery of Tampa Bay in early 2019 after serving congregations in Virginia and Florida and as a Navy Reserve Chaplain (with almost half of his 33 years recalled or mobilized to active duty). Ordained in 1985, he has theological degrees from Princeton Theological Seminary and a law degree from Stetson Law.

He moved to Tampa Bay in 1996 to serve with Rev. Dr. Holly Wildhack as co-pastors of Maximo Presbyterian Church in St. Petersburg, but his primary ministry after 9/11 was as a chaplain until he retired from the Navy in 2016 while serving as part-time supply pastor at First, Safety Harbor.

Today, son Evan and daughter Jocelyn are both ministers of Word and Sacrament in the PC(USA).
