### Welcome Guest Preacher Holly Dillon

Reverend Holly Dillon's roots are in Illinois, where she attended a small, Quaker church in the country. After graduating from college, she attended a Quaker seminary, graduating with a M.Div. degree in 1983. From 1982-1987, she served as a co-pastor in a Quaker church in Indiana. After taking some time to raise children, she responded to an ad for a Christian educator at a PC(USA) church. For the next two decades, she served churches in Indiana and Colorado as a Certified Christian educator. In 2012, she received her D. Ed. Min. degree from Columbia Theological Seminary.

In 2013, Holly transferred her ordination from the Quaker church to the PC (USA). In 2015, she moved to Florida, where she served at Palms Presbyterian Church as an Associate Pastor from 2015-2020. She served as the Ministry and Mission Coordinator in the Presbytery of St. Augustine prior to arriving in the Tampa Bay Presbytery in late September, 2022 where she serves as the General Presbyter.

Holly has three adult children and one granddaughter who will be 1 year old in May. When she's not in a zoom meeting, or traveling around the presbytery, Holly enjoys fishing, exploring Florida with her husband, and watching sunsets.

### Sing the Christmas Cantata

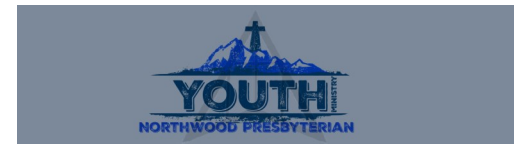
