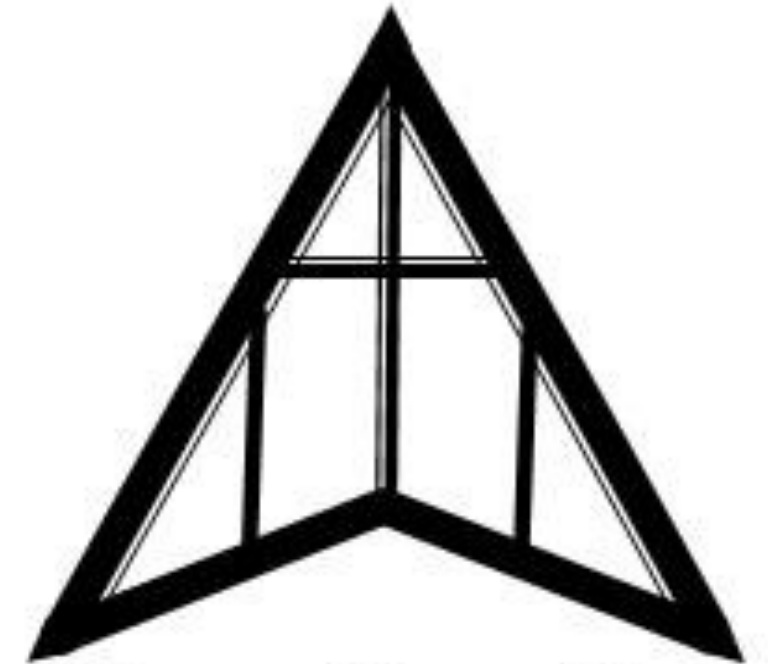

CALL TO CONFESSION
