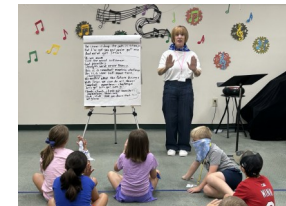
## Church Office Closed, July 3
