In observance of Labor Day, the church office will be closed Monday, September 7th. Calls to the office will be handled by the voicemail system and returned on Tuesday, September 8th.

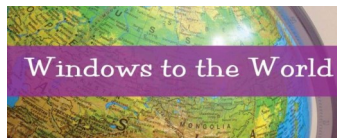
