Giving intended for 2023 must be received in the church office by noon on Friday, December 29th or postmarked no later than December 29, 2023. Contributions which are processed electronically through your bank's online bill pay or via our website must be initiated much earlier (probably no later than December 27) so that the transaction will fully process and qualify for deduction in 2023.
