In about 610 A.D. a very creative Alpine monk decided to make use of the pieces of dough left over from baking bread. The monk formed them into thin strips folded into a looped twist to represent the folded arms of children in prayer. This scrumptious treat was given to the children as they learned their prayers. They began calling the treat "Pretiola", which is Latin for "little reward". Soon it was known the world over as a pretzel.

Many churches still practice the tradition of a Pretzel Sunday to remind people to be in prayer as we journey through Lent to Easter. So, every time you see a pretzel, remember prayer.
