Email Scam Alert
Some of our members and church staff have once again received fraudulent emails that appear to be from Pastor Chris. The best way to deal with this is for you to block the sender and/or forward the email to the church office so that we can collect them for the police. It saddens us when anyone seeks to do harm and prey on the Christian kindness of our members. Be aware of such scams and do not respond to them!
