Patricia (Patsy) Donnelly Callan, 84, of Dunedin Fl. and Newton Ma. Was called home to heaven to be with her beloved husband of 40 years, Arthur (Papa) Callan, 92, who passed just two weeks before. They met at the United Methodist Church in Newton MA where he served as treasurer and she as organist. The couple had been residents of Dunedin for the past 20 years.

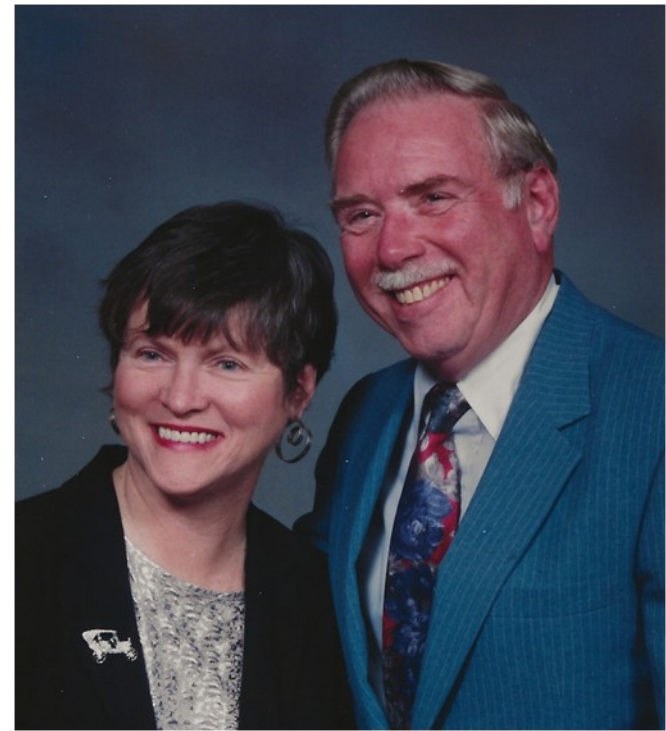
Highly accomplished, Patsy is a graduate of Durfee HS, Fall River, MA, member of Mu Phi Epsilon while attending Boston University on a music scholarship, she went on to a full career as educator from the Cambridge MA Public Schools. She was friend to many, an avid reader and writer of poetry, author of several plays, a professional musician, organist, choir director, voice teacher and lifetime supporter of the arts.

Arthur graduated Stoneham High School in 1947, served in the Massachusetts National Guard from 1948 to 1956 and earned a degree in Business from Northeastern University. He was founder of the William F. Buckley scholarship for a fallen classmate and prisoner of war. Following a career in office management and accounting, he was an avid member of the Minuteman Model A Ford Club, Executive Director of the Model A Ford Foundation from 1998 to 2016 and instrumental in establishing a new museum in Michigan where he was inducted into the Model A Ford Hall of Fame in 2022.

Together, they were devoted members of the church, shared many travel adventures, and were fiercely loyal and devoted to their combined families. She had a quick wit and a beautiful smile that she shared often. He will be remembered for his charisma, good humor, generosity and loving manner.

Patsy is predeceased by her brother John Valentine Donnelly Jr. of Somerset, Ma. and her sister Mary (Meg) Donnelly Peterson of Annapolis, Md. She was sister to Ellen Hardgrave, brother Thomas Donnelly both of Clearwater, Fl. and sister Anne Donnelly of Fall River, MA. Arthur was older brother to Howard of Orlando, FL and to David Callan and Jalna Jaeger of Norwalk, CT. They are also survived by, their beloved children Christine and David Reycroft, John, Kathleen, James, Jeffrey, and Daniel Callan, their spouses, 12 grandchildren, and many nieces and nephews.
