Domestic Violence Services (DVS)

In 2023, DVS began as a pilot program in April. 15 people served 168 meals; and 28 Easter baskets/animals and 23 Mother's Day bag touched 247 persons. In October, CUMC did a pop-up of 150 ChapStick containers for DVS services and awareness during Domestic Violence month.
