- Read Acts 2:42-47
 - What does this passage say about the actions of the fellowship of believers? What do they do?
 - How do you think the actions of the fellowship lead to the expansion of the church?
 - What are the actions of the fellowship that you see also reflected in our church?
 - What are the actions of the fellowship that you DON'T see reflected in our church?
 - Why do you think they are missing from our fellowship?
 - Should they be missing? Why or why not?
 - What do you think the scripture means in v.44 when it says, "they had everything in common."
 - Do you think that is true about the people in our church? Why or why not?
 - What do you think it means that "The Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved?"
 - Do you see this happening in our context? How do you think our baptism goal fits into this?
- Are you or someone you know ready to be baptized? Let your leader know to get that info to Pastor Nick!
