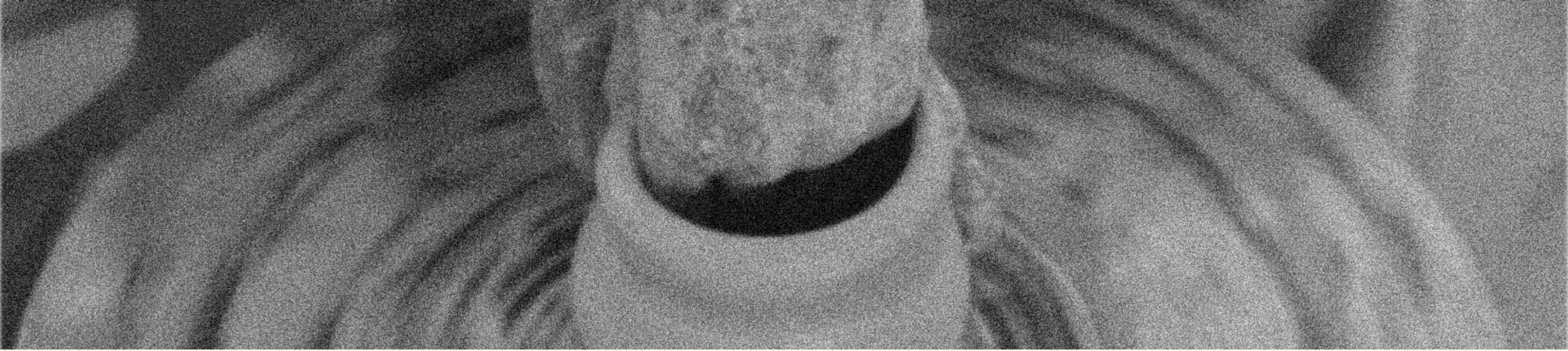

OVERVIEW

Have you ever started a project you never finished? Maybe it was a book you never completed. A puzzle with a few pieces still missing. A home improvement project that's been sitting half-done for months. An instrument you meant to learn. A workout routine. A language. A hobby. Most of us have a list of unfinished projects somewhere in our lives.

God doesn't.

Throughout history, God has been writing a story much bigger than a single lifetime. Think about the great cathedrals of Europe. They were built through the faithful labor of people who knew they would never see the finished building. Still, they gladly gave themselves to the work because they believed they were part of something bigger than themselves.

God's work is different from ours. We leave projects unfinished because we lose interest, run out of time, exhaust our resources, or simply move on.

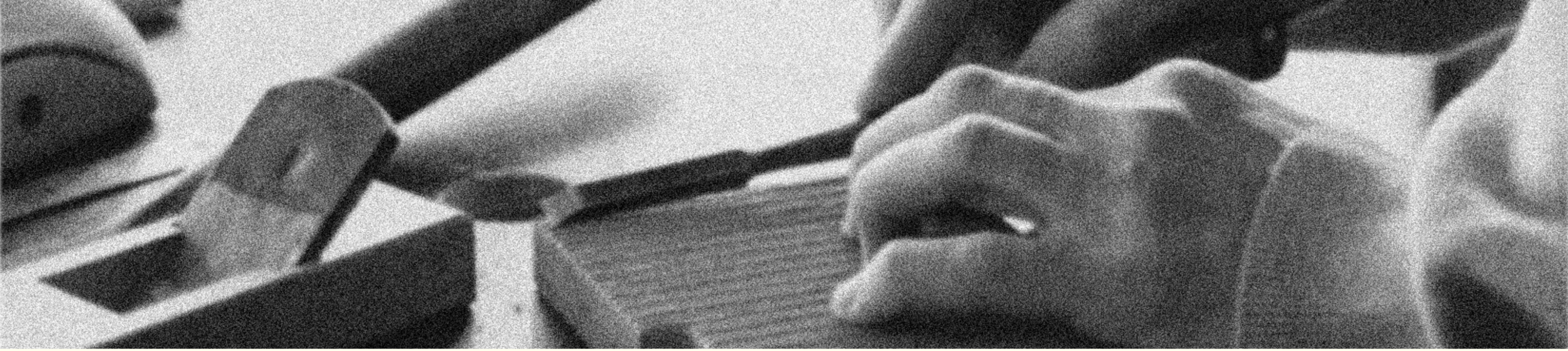
God never does.

DAY 01

GOD IS STILL AT WORK...IN ME.

KEY SCRIPTURE:

Philippians 1:6 (CSB)

"I am sure of this, that He who started a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus."

FOCUS

One of the greatest lies we can believe is that God has given up on us. Maybe you've struggled with the same sin again. Maybe you've prayed the same prayer for years. Maybe you've wondered why change seems so slow. **But God is not discouraged by the work He has begun in you.**

The same God who called you is the same God who is changing you. He is patient. He is faithful. He never abandons what He starts. Spiritual growth rarely happens overnight. God shapes us one step, one prayer, and one act of obedience at a time.

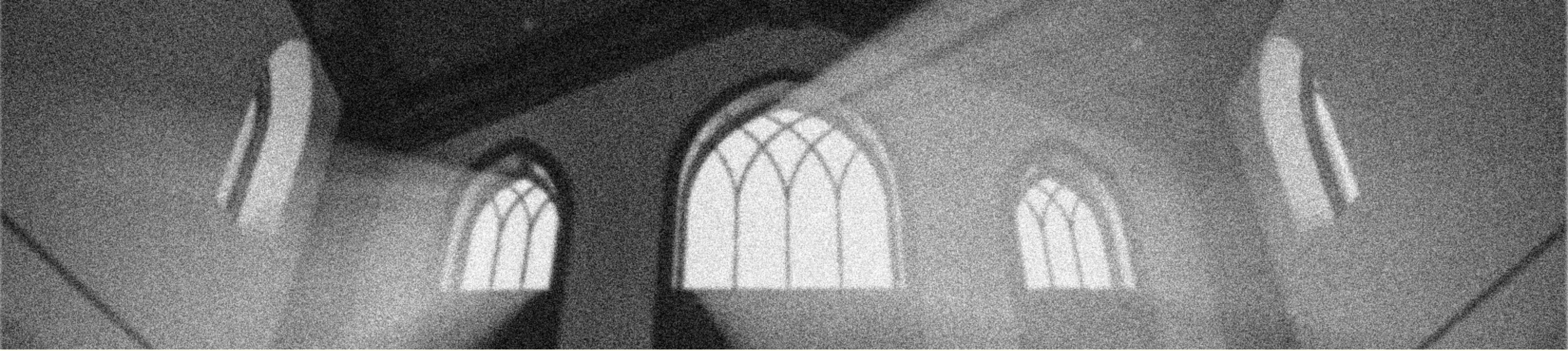
As we begin this prayer guide, remember this: you are not who you once were, and by God's grace, you are not yet who you will be. God is still at work in you.

REFLECT

- Where have I become discouraged in my walk with God, forgetting that He is still at work in me?
- What is one area of my life where I need to trust God's ongoing work instead of trying to change in my own strength?

PRAY

Father, Thank You for beginning a good work in me. When I become discouraged by my failures or impatient with my growth, remind me that You are not finished with me. Give me faith to trust Your timing, courage to keep saying "yes" to Your leading, and a heart that is willing to be shaped by You each day. Continue Your work in me until I become more like Jesus. Amen.



DAY 02

GOD IS STILL AT WORK...IN HIS CHURCH.

KEY SCRIPTURE:

Matthew 16:18 (CSB)

"...I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overpower it."

FOCUS

Jesus never promised that His Church would be perfect. He did promise that **He would build it**. For over two thousand years, the Church has faced persecution, division, hardship, and opposition. Yet through every generation, Jesus has remained faithful to His promise.

The Church is more than a building or a weekly gathering. It is God's people, redeemed by His grace and sent into the world with the hope of the gospel. Sometimes it's easy to become discouraged by what we see. But Jesus is not discouraged. He is still saving people. Still transforming lives. Still raising up disciples. **Still building His Church.**

As we pray today, let's thank God for His faithfulness through every generation and look forward with faith to all He will continue to do. **God is still at work in His Church.**

REFLECT

- How can I be more fully engaged in the work God is doing through His Church?
- Is there someone God is inviting me to encourage, serve, or disciple as we build His Church together?

PRAY

Father, Thank You for making me part of Your Church. Thank You for Your faithfulness through every generation. Continue building Your Church, beginning with me. Unite us in love, strengthen us by Your Spirit, and help us faithfully share the hope of Jesus with those around us. May our church reflect Your heart and bring glory to Your name as You continue Your work in our community and throughout the world. Amen.



DAY 03

GOD IS STILL AT WORK...IN OUR CITY.

KEY SCRIPTURE:

2 Peter 3:9 (CSB)

"The Lord does not delay His promise, as some understand delay, but is patient with you, not wanting any to perish but all to come to repentance."

FOCUS

When Jesus looked at the crowds, He didn't see interruptions or obstacles. He saw people He loved. **That same heart is still at work today.**

Every neighborhood, every school, every workplace, and every home is filled with people who need the hope of Jesus. God has not forgotten our city. He is still drawing people to Himself, changing lives, restoring families, and bringing hope where it is needed most. **And He invites His Church to join Him.**

As we celebrate what God has done, let's also pray for what He will do. May He open doors for the gospel, soften hearts to receive His truth, and use us to share the love of Christ with those around us. The story isn't over. **God is still at work in our city.**

REFLECT

PRAY

Father, Thank You for loving our city more than we ever could. Open our eyes to see people the way You see them. Fill us with compassion, boldness, and wisdom as we share the hope of Jesus. Continue drawing people to Yourself, restoring families, and transforming communities by Your grace.

As You build Your Church, make us into a church that looks like heaven. May we be a people from every background, every generation, and every story, united in Christ and committed to making Him known. Continue Your work throughout our city. Amen.
