How Much Is the Cost Of Camp?

Early Registration is ***\$110 per person until August 18***

Regular Registration is ***\$140 per person until September 8***

Late Registration is ***\$160 per person until September 15***

What are the sleeping arrangements?

Students will be assigned to male-only and female-only RVR cabins (mostly bunk bed style). Two to four adult leaders (male leaders in the boys' cabin and female leaders in the girls' cabin) are placed in each cabin to host our students, lead devotionals/discussions, and direct the students throughout our retreat.

How many adults will attend?

At Grace Covenant Church, we maintain a ratio of 1 adult leader to every 10 students. We value discipleship, so our adult leaders are not just chaperones; they are mentors who build relationships with the students, minister to them, pray with them, and love them the way Christ would. They also ensure your child has a fun and enriching time at camp.

How do you ensure students avoid ending up walking around by themselves?

Rest assured, we prioritize the safety of every student. One of our 'Camp Rules' is that **no student is allowed to walk around by themselves**. We go over this rule, and a few others, in detail during our opening night, ensuring a secure and enjoyable experience for all.



What are the food arrangements at Camp Collide?

Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are included in the Camp Collide registration fee. If your student has severe food allergies, please indicate them in the registration form. For students with food allergies, families will receive a form to share details of an appropriate diet for their student(s) while at camp.

How can I reach my child during the weekend?

Your student can have their cell phones at all times during camp, but they cannot use them during service times. We encourage students to fully engage in sessions and camp activities throughout the retreat.

Should students pack snacks for camp?

You may pack additional snacks for in-between meal times if desired. RVR also has a snack shop available for students to purchase snacks. Campers should bring money if they desire to purchase food from the snack shop.
