- External
 - Earliest manuscripts (including LXX/Septuagint)
 - Early Jewish (ex. Josephus, Talmud) and Christians
 - Masoretes final book notation at end of Nehemiah (none found at end of Ezra); total verses, mid-point in Neh. 3:22-23
- Internal
 - Themes
 - Book of the Law (Ezra 7:6, 10 vs. Nehemiah 8:1)
 - Separation from Foreigners (Ezra 9:1-10:44 vs. Neh. 9:2; 10:29)
 - Dates 7th year Ezra 7:7 vs. 20th year Nehemiah 1:1
 - Events Destroyed Walls (Ezra 4:12, 13 vs. Nehemiah 1:3)
