GEORGE – The coming of Jesus Christ into human history was not an accidental happening....Not only was the incarnation the fulfillment of myriads of Old Testament prophecies, but it also was the culmination of a plan devised within the eternal council of the triune God before the creation of the world.

CALVIN – The time which had been ordained by the Providence of God was seasonable and fit.... Therefore the right time for the Son of God to be revealed to the world was for God alone to judge and determine.

I. IT HAPPENED AT A PARTICULAR TIME

4 But when the fullness of the time came, God sent forth His Son...

1 John 4:14 - the Father has sent the Son to be the Savior of the world.

John 1:1 - In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

John 8:58 - Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I am."

John 17:5 - Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was.

John 5:18 - the Jews were seeking all the more to kill Him, because He...was calling God His own Father, making Himself equal with God.

Col 2:9 - For in Him all the fullness of Deity dwells in bodily form...

Heb 1:3 - He is the radiance of His glory and the exact representation of His nature...

GEORGE – God sent His son not just from Galilee to Jerusalem, nor just from the manger to the cross, but all the way from heaven to earth....In sending Jesus, God did not send a substitute or a surrogate. He came Himself.

SCHREINER – If God rules over history, we can trust Him with the particulars of our lives as well. We may agonize about particular sufferings in our lives: health problems, circumstances that are difficult, or the timing of the death of loved ones. Usually we don't understand such hard things. Even though we don't fully grasp why sufferings happen to us, we cling to the promise of God's love for us, and we trust that He will strengthen us for whatever comes our way.
