SPURGEON – *What an abyss is the grace of God! Who can measure its breadth? Who can fathom its depth? Like all the rest of the divine attributes, it is infinite....It is because ‘His mercy endureth forever’ that men are not destroyed; because ‘His compassions fail not’ that sinners are brought to Him and forgiven.*

KECK – *What occurs through Christ reverses and surpasses what occurred through Adam.*

SCHREINER – *It is one thing to blemish what is beautiful, but it is much harder to set straight what is already crooked.*

***Matt 1:21** - She will bear a Son; and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins.*

***Isa 53:11-12** - 11... the Righteous One, My Servant, will justify the many, as He will bear their iniquities. 12 ... He Himself bore the sin of many, and interceded for the transgressors.*

***Matt 20:28** - just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.*

CRANFIELD – That one single misdeed should be answered by judgment – this is perfectly understandable. But that the accumulated sins and guilt of all the ages should be answered by God's free gift – this is the miracle of miracles...

Two results of God's grace...

- I. IT TURNS CONDEMNATION INTO JUSTIFICATION
- II. IT TURNS DEATH INTO LIFE

MARTYN LLOYD-JONES – *Over and above being forgiven, the righteousness of Jesus Christ is put to our account...you and I are not merely given back a human righteousness, the righteousness that Adam had before he fell – we are given the righteousness of Jesus Christ. “Much more” – abundance, superabundance – give full weight to it! We receive this abundance of grace and the gift of righteousness.*
