I. THE CONTRAST IN ACTION

18 So then as through one transgression there resulted condemnation to all men, even so through one act of righteousness there resulted justification of life to all men.

*2 Pet 1:3-4 - ... His divine power has granted to us everything pertaining to **life** and godliness, through the true knowledge of Him ... 4...(we have become) become partakers of the **divine nature**...*

*Rom 6:4 - ...we...walk in newness of **life**.*

*John 3:15 - ... whoever believes will in Him have **eternal life**.*

*John 17:3 - This is **eternal life**, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.*

Rom 8:32 - He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him over for us all, how will He not also with Him freely give us all things?

Rom 12:18 – If possible, so far as it depends on you, be at peace with all men.

Rom 14:2 - One person has faith that he may eat all things, but he who is weak eats vegetables only.

Rom 16:19 - For the report of your obedience has reached to all...

1 Tim 2:1–2 - 1 ... I urge that entreaties and prayers, petitions and thanksgivings, be made on behalf of all men, 2 for kings and all who are in authority...

1 Cor 15:21-23 - 21... by a man came death, by a man also came the resurrection of the dead. 22...in Adam all die, so also in Christ all will be made alive. 23...those who are Christ's...

2 Thes 1:8–9 - 8 dealing out retribution to those who do not know God and to those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. 9 These will pay the penalty of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord...

Matt 24:51 - ... in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Jer 11:10 - They have turned back to the iniquities of their ancestors who refused to hear My words...

Luke 12:14 - ...who appointed Me a judge or arbitrator over you?

Acts 7:10 - ... he made him governor over Egypt and all his household.

Titus 1:5 - ... appoint elders in every city as I directed you...

Phil 2:8 - ... He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

- *active obedience*

Gal 4:4 – (Jesus was) born under the Law...

- *passive obedience*

II. THE CONTRAST IN STATUS

19 For as through the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, even so through the obedience of the One the many will be made righteous.

NASELLI – *Adam made a mess, and Christ not only cleaned up the mess but gives believing sinners the status of righteous.*

Gen 3:7 - Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves loin coverings.

Gen 3:21 - The Lord God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife, and clothed them.

1 Pet 5:5 – ...God is opposed to the proud, but gives grace to the humble.
