Salvation:	Gospel + Faith + Works in some way
Promises life:	IF we repent, believe, try harder & ...
Forgiveness:	“Car Wash” Forgiveness Is limited & temporary (repeated) Confess your sins & ask for forgiveness
Goal:	Trying not to sin so much
Key Identity:	Sinner ‘saved by grace’
Focus:	Keeping the Law/God’s rules
Confidence:	Self-confident: trusting myself
Holy Spirit	Secondary: not really needed
Assurance of Salvation:	Not possible (our works never enough)
How to live:	TRYING: “I with Jesus’ help”

Gospel + Trusting only Jesus’ work
IF we trust only in Jesus & HIS WORK
Big “F” Forgiveness: complete & final Moment you trust Jesus alone to save you Little “F” Forgiveness: for fellowship
Learning to trust Jesus in all things
Saint who still does sin
Trusting Jesus 24/7... living in Spirit
Christ-confident: trusting Jesus
Primary: absolutely needed always
Possible, promised & is God’s plan for every believer
TRUSTING: “Not I but Christ living”

Water Baptism

Water baptism is an act of obedience by a person who has already trusted Jesus Christ as their Savior and therefore is a saved person. Water baptism pictures what happened to us spiritually the moment we trusted Jesus as our Savior. It is a public statement we are Christians and want to follow Jesus in all areas of our life. We desire to live this way, because Jesus has changed our life. Baptism symbolizes our death to the old life we once had when we were guilty because of our sins and lived under the power and authority of sin. Baptism also proclaims our new life of forgiveness and power through Jesus’ resurrection and our new union with Him by the Spirit.
