## ROLE SUMMARY

A part-time (25 hours/wk) staff position with responsibility for assisting our Rockpoint Kids ministry with administrative, office and ministry functions. Hours will occasionally increase during more demanding ministry events such as VBS or special family events.

## **QUALIFICATIONS**

- 1. Belief in Jesus Christ and in agreement with the views and principles of Rockpoint Church, including the EFCA Statement of Faith.
- 2. Able to maintain confidentiality
- 3. Able to respond to people in a friendly, warm, and helpful manner. Relates well to children's ministry staff, volunteers and families.
- 4. Needs to possess good organizational and administrative skills
- 5. Experience and competence with computer and software applications (Microsoft Office, Planning Center Online, Teams and Leadr).
- 6. Able to take direction as well as initiate new projects
- 7. Church ministry experience, either paid or volunteer, is a plus.
- 8. A flexible, problem-solving approach and a heart for ministry.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

#### 1) Communications

- a) Assist with ministry communications via email, phone calls, texts, social media and mailings
- b) Work in conjunction with our communications team to ensure the creation of promo pieces such as flyers, posters, website and social media postings for upcoming ministry events
- c) Answer questions, provide information, and help problem solve with staff, volunteers and families
- d) Keep Rockpoint Kids staff informed of ongoing needs with families or individuals as they become known.
- e) Manage our Rockpoint Kids Care ministry by sending cards, flowers or gift cards to those who need extra encouragement.

#### 2) Administration

- a) Perform general administrative duties such as printing, copying, database maintenance, updating the church calendar, reserving rooms and ordering ministry supplies.
- b) Proficiency in use and administration of PCO and Approved Workman databases, including the ability to troubleshoot and problem solve issues.
- c) Provide administrative support for Rockpoint Kids' events such as VBS, training meetings, seasonal events, Awana events, etc. Oversee registration processes, check in and procedures for these events.



- d) Purchase supplies and materials as requested by the ministry directors.
- 3) Programming/Events
  - a) Scheduling and communication with Sunday AM volunteers. Work collaboratively with Elementary Ministry Director and Awana Ministry Director for Awana and special event staffing.
  - b) Assist ministry directors with curriculum prep, room setup, classroom supplies, providing name badges for volunteers and other office functions that will support their ministry area.
  - c) Help purchase or provide food for ministry lunches, dinners, trainings and appreciation events.
  - d) Help organize and manage the details of our Faith Path classes such as Child Dedication, First Bible and Baptism. Communicate with families and participants as needed.
- 4) Preferred work schedule would be daytime hours Monday-Thursday. Specific schedule can be discussed with the Children's Pastor. Your involvement in the following "All Hands On Deck" events is also required. During these weeks/times you can adjust your work schedule so hours are in alignment with your work agreement.
  - a) March or April—Good Friday Family event and at least one of the Easter services
  - b) May—VBS kickoff lunch
  - c) June—VBS leader training
  - d) July—VBS leader training, the week prior to VBS and the week of VBS
  - e) September—Fall Kickoff lunch
  - f) December—Christmas Choir Sunday
- 5) Team relationships
  - a) Meet weekly with the RP Kids staff
  - b) Attend other team meetings as needed

#### HISTORY

In 1968, ten families took a leap of faith and began praying over a shared dream of establishing a church in the northeast suburbs. By 1969, they had begun meeting for worship at an elementary school.

Lakewood Evangelical Free Church was officially chartered by the State of Minnesota and formally recognized as part of the Evangelical Free Church of America in 1972. A search for a permanent home led to the construction of a portion of our former facility, completed in the spring of 1973.

As Lakewood's people lived out their commitment to minister to the surrounding community, the congregation experienced significant growth during the 1980s. Space became inadequate for the quality ministries the church sought to provide. Phase 1 of a new facility addition was completed in 1986. However, when Phase 2 was considered, it became clear that the current site was too small.

To continue expanding its ministry and impact, the congregation voted in 1996 to purchase 108 acres of land and relocated to Lake Elmo. Through prayer and sacrificial giving, God miraculously provided the \$1 million needed to purchase the land. After years of collaboration with the city, our new facility was completed, and our first Sunday service was held in July of 2007.

In anticipation of this move, the church also changed its name from Lakewood Evangelical Free Church to Rockpoint Church, ready to launch ministry into a new region.

Throughout our history, countless prayers and sacrificial giving of time, talents, and treasures have marked our journey. Based on God's faithfulness, and with humble dependence on Him, our leadership believes the Holy Spirit is prompting us to pursue a new work—locally and globally. As we step into Rockpoint's future, we believe God will continue doing a fresh work in the lives of each person, in our community, in the Northeast Metro area of the Twin Cities, across the nation, and around the world.

#### **GOVERNANCE**

Rockpoint Church is part of the Evangelical Free Church of America and is congregation-led. This means the following items require approval by a majority of church members:

- Annual budget
- Placement of the Senior Pastor
- Appointment of Elders and Deacons
- Sale of properties (as outlined in our bylaws)

#### Elder and Deacon Boards:

- The Elder Board is comprised of men only.
- Both men and women serve on the Deacon Board.
- The Senior Pastor is a voting member of the Elder Board and is accountable to it.
- The Executive Pastor is a non-voting member of the Elder Board and oversees all staff, reporting directly to the Senior Pastor.

The Elder Board is responsible for the overall direction and spiritual life of the church. Once vision and direction are established, the implementation is carried out by the pastoral staff under the leadership of the Senior and Executive Pastors.
