· Curriculum

Pre-K uses the High Reach Curriculum.

This curriculum is more like what the students will receive in kindergarten. It includes instruction in the following areas — Social Studies, Science, Math and Language Arts. We infuse the curriculum with seasonal and religious activities.

Security

All doors are locked during the school day. All entrances have cameras and are monitored by church staff.

Training

All staff are CPR/First Aid Trained. We renew our certification every 2 years.

Teachers attend training whenever available to stay up on new ideas for their classrooms.

Daily Schedule

Students begin their day with the pledge, calendar activities, and review or learn new skills and topics at group time. They continue their learning by participating in Centers. They will have a snack. At the end of the morning students will have outdoor play on the playground or in the gym.

· Lunch Bunch

Students may stay on Tuesday through Thursday till 2 for an additional charge of \$7.00 per day. Students will eat their lunch that parents provide and have extra play time. We do not take naps.

Field Trips/Visitors

We have several field trips scheduled for the school year. Parents take their child to the field trip destination. Children are the responsibility of their parents while at the destination.
