USE THESE QUESTIONS AND RESOURCES TO HELP YOU PROCESS THE MESSAGE IN YOUR PERSONAL STUDY TIME OR WITH YOUR GROUP.

Message Recap: How do you know when to invite someone to church? Follow the cues. Sometimes things aren't going well in someone's life. That's a good time for them to come and see Jesus. Sometimes a person isn't prepared for the season they are living. That's an excellent time to offer an invitation to come and see. But an invitation doesn't have to be about solving a problem or dealing with a difficult situation. Sometimes a person just needs to come and see Jesus. Follow the cues.

Main Points

- We know the who's by paying attention to the cues.
 - Things are **not** going well.
 - They were **not** prepared for this.
 - They are **not** in church.

Setting Started

• Did your church experience begin with an invitation from someone? If so, how do you feel about that person?

Observation

- Read and reflect on John 4:4-42
- What are your initial reactions to this passage? What do you find challenging? Are you encouraged by any of these verses? Why?



• This week look for the cues, the three nots. Then, when you hear them, don't miss the chance to invite them to Come and See.



- Have you ever invited someone to come and see Jesus? Was it worth the risk? What happened?
- Read John 4:4–26. What stands out about how Jesus interacts with the woman at the well? Why does it stand out to you?
- What are some things that stand in the way of you inviting someone to come and see? What can you do to overcome those obstacles?
- Who is close to you but far from God? What is your best next step with that person? Do you need to begin to invest in a relationship with them? Do you need to offer an invitation to come and see?



• This week, have each family member pick someone close to them but far from Jesus, and, as a family, pray for opportunities and cues to invite them to church. Then, use a time like dinner or bedtime to pray for those people and cues continually!

>> Next Steps and Prayer

- The people in Samaria came to see Jesus because the woman shared her story with them. Nobody can invalidate your story and your experience. Who might need to hear your story about how Jesus has made your life better?
- Close by praying that God would give you the "cues to the who's" in your life that are ready to hear your story. Ask that he would give you the boldness to invite them to Come and See.
